COMPETITION RULES

Rules: USANKF Rules of Competition (modified)

Kata: All Beginner/Novice Divisions

- 1. Competitors perform simultaneously, two at a time.
- 2. Competitors may perform only katas listed:

Kihon Pinan Gekisai Fukyu Heian Kanshiwa

Taikyoku

- 3. Competitors may repeat kata in all rounds.
- 4. All divisions repechage.

Intermediate/Advanced Divisions

- 1. Competitors perform simultaneously, two at a time, in elimination rounds.
- 2. Competitors perform individually in the gold medal round.
- 3. May perform any kata.
- 4. Must perform a different kata (not performed in previous round) in the gold medal round.
- 5. All divisions repechage.

Kobudo

- 1. Point totals determine winners.
- 2. All divisions single elimination.

Kumite: Scoring and match time

- 1. All divisions: Referee and two corner Judge system
- 2. All divisions: 1-1/2 minutes, stop time, 8 point ceiling (first competitor to attain 8 points wins).
- 3. All divisions: repechage

Prohibited Behavior:

1. Age 18 and over: non-injurious, light controlled "touch" contact to the face, head, and neck is allowed (but not to the throat) with hand and foot.

Non-injurious, controlled touch to the body is allowed with hand and foot techniques.

2. Age 12-17: no touch or contact to the head, face, and neck is allowed with hand techniques.

Jodan kicks may make the lightest touch ("skin touch") and score.

Non-injurious, controlled touch to the body allowed with hand and foot techniques.

3. Age 11 and under: no contact to the face, head, and neck.

No sweeping or takedown techniques.

Non-injurious, controlled touch to the body allowed with hand and foot techniques.

Ten Second Rule: No ten second rule for divisions up to and including age 11.

Mandatory Equipment:

1. All divisions: all white karate-gi (dojo patch permitted), fist guards (red, blue), mouth guard, groin protector (males).

Optional Equipment:

1. Shin pads/foot pads (USANKF, WKF type), body protector, head protector.

Team Champion:

To be determined by the <u>highest aggregate score resulting from all team divisions</u>. Placings in each division: first place = 3 points, second place = 2 points, third place = 1 point. Scores from multiple team entries from the same dojo in the same division will not be combined, e.g., if Colorado Budokan Team A and Colorado Budokan Team B are competing in division TK1 their scores cannot be combined. Each team will be considered a separate entity.

Two Corner Judge System For Kumite

- 1. Referee will call points, warnings and penalties.
- 2. The Judges will show points and prohibited techniques.
- 3. When calling yame the Referee must simultaneously indicate with correct hand signal his opinion (red or blue), return to the Referee position, indicate scoring level, warning, or penalty then render a decision.
- 4. For awarding points, assessing warnings or penalties the Referee must have the support of one of the Judges.
- 5. If the two judges or one judge and the referee show different points for the same competitor, majority opinion will determine point(s) to be awarded.
- 6. The Referee must stop the match if both flags signal point for the same competitor.
- 7. The Referee cannot ask for reconsideration of points.
